Tuition Financing

Parents/guardians who do not have access to a computer or who need help completing an application are encouraged to sign up for the loan program during registration night.

Financial Assistance

Financial assistance is based strictly upon financial need. Financial aid applications will only be reviewed once the student is fully registered and accepted. Qualified families are determined by the information submitted in the financial aid application through FACTS. Generally, financial aid is not granted for more than half of the cost of tuition and does not cover the registration fee, uniforms, or books. Financial aid is *not* automatically renewed; a new application must be submitted each year.

Mid-Year Tuition and Fees

The mid-year tuition and fee amount will be half the cost of tuition and fees per grade level; this amount will not include the registration fee of \$500 which is paid annually by every student.
