I sincerely hope you are well.

On Monday, November 15th, please know that every De La Salle student will be sent home with a packet of ten (10) raffle tickets, with each ticket valued at \$10.00.

As a means of supporting De La Salle High School, these proceeds support our **Maroon and White Gala**, to be held on campus on Saturday, March 19, 2022. The theme of the gala is *Athens on the Avenue*, and the funds we raise will go toward upgrading our facilities, supporting academic and financial aid, hiring and retaining quality faculty and staff, and other areas of need.

We are asking all students to help support De La Salle by selling their ten raffle tickets and turning in both tickets stubs and cash or checks to the De La Salle Development Office.

Students who successfully sell their ten tickets by February 4, 2022, will receive a school holiday on Friday, February 25, 2022, and the purchaser of the ticket will have a chance at a \$5,000.00 cash prize.

Please know that these tickets are considered to be “cash,” and every student MUST turn in either \$10.00 dollars per ticket sold, and/or the unsold tickets (we will not accept unsold returned tickets until the second semester). Students who misplace tickets or do not turn in tickets by the conclusion of the school day on Friday, February 4, 2022, will be charged \$10.00 per missing ticket. We will announce the importance of the tickets to our students repeatedly, along with reminders of the February 4th due date of all tickets (sold or unsold), ticket stubs, and monies collected.

Again, students are responsible for returning all of the money for tickets and any remaining unsold tickets. Each student is responsible for the tickets issued to them.
